



New unique Internship Available at OSU

SOC 489 - a 5-credit Internship

The Ohio State University-Newark has entered into a partnership with the Licking County Probate and Juvenile Court in order to offer the first **SOC 489: Internship** of its kind. In Autumn 2009, Ohio State Newark will offer an opportunity for OSU-N students to tutor and mentor court-involved youth.

Specifically, 10 youth will be matched with 10 OSU-N students to assist in Jr. High and High School course work, as well as provide the much needed college socialization experiences to youth, such as providing a tour of the campus and participate in coordinated meetings with COTC and OSU-N admissions and advising offices.

The program brings college students and “at risk” youth together in a University setting to develop a strong partnership between institutions of higher learning, local schools, and the local juvenile court.

Class times/location: Mentors and Mentees will meet a minimum of three hours each week at OSU-N. The meetings are likely to occur in the after school or evening hours, but will be coordinated between mentors and mentees

Enrollment: 10 undergraduate and/or graduate OSU-N students.
